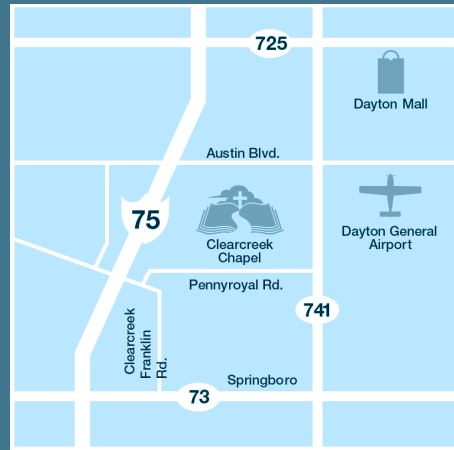
Advanced Training
